

Using the ARC-BC Pictello Files

Pictello is an iPad/iPhone/iPod touch app and so .pictello files can be viewed on iPad, iPhone or iPod Touch. To use ARC-BC .pictello files on iPad, please follow the steps below.


Importing ARC-BC .pictello files into Pictello on your iPad:

1. Go to the ARC-BC website, download and save the .pictello file onto your computer


2. Connect your iPad to your computer and open iTunes
 3. a. Select your device (eg. ARC's iPad) (Version 10) and go to Apps.
 b. If you are using iTunes 11, click on iPad or the name of your iPad on the upper right hand corner. Then click on the Apps tab from the list of tabs along the top of the summary screen that opens




4. Scroll down to see the File Sharing pane where you see all the apps you have on the iPad
 5. Click Pictello in the Apps panel on the left and then click Add at the bottom on the right




6. Browse your computer to locate the .pictello file you just downloaded and double click the file name or click Open to add it to Pictello on your iPad. You can also drag the file into the Pictello Document panel



7. Select Sync at the bottom of the iTunes window.	
8. Start Pictello on your iPad, you will see the Pictello file added to the Library	

You can also download an ARC .pictello file directly onto your iPad and open it in Pictello. To do this, please follow the steps below.

1. Search for the file your student needs and download it using Safari on your iPad.
2. When you see this page after clicking on Download, click on the link for the file.


Click on the download links to get your files. The links work for you only, and are kept in your account until they expire in 7 days.



3. You will see the window below. Tap Open in "Pictello".



4. The file opens in Pictello.

Playing back an ARC-BC Pictello story:

<p>1. Start Pictello on your iPad, you will see a list of stories. To read a story, tap the row for the story</p>	
<p>2. You will see the title photo of the book and at the bottom Slideshow mode button which is turned OFF by default, which means page turning is manual. Tap anywhere on the picture to start reading the story</p>	
<p>3. You can swipe to the left or right to turn pages. Or you can use the next page and previous page button to turn the pages, and use the Home button in the middle to go back to Library or to the list of stories</p>	
<p>4. If you would like to play back the story in the Slideshow mode, swipe the button to turn it on and tap anywhere on the picture to start reading the story. Each page will turn automatically, after a set number of seconds.</p>	
<p>5. To change the number of seconds per page and the transition used between pages, tap Option button at the bottom of the Library window and make any changes there</p>	
<p>6. While playing back the story in the slideshow mode, you can bring up controls by tapping anywhere on the screen. You can go back or forward in the story, stop the slideshow or resume playing the slideshow.</p>	
<p>7. When you reach the end of the story, you can Read Story Again, go Back to Library or change playback mode before reading story again.</p>
