ARC-BC provides digital versions of textbooks and novels that BC educators are using in their classrooms. These books have been converted from hard copy print into special digital files called **alternate formats**. These files support many accessibility features, such as the ability to have software read the book aloud to support learning.

Is ARC-BC for my student(s)?

The Copyright Act of Canada allows for alternate formats to be created for students with perceptual disabilities. A perceptual disability results in significant difficulties seeing, holding, or understanding a work in its original format and generally encompasses:
